REASON FOR HEARING

Appeal by Tesco Stores Limited.,

Relating to the application to East Lindsey District Council for the Erection of a food store with a service yard enclosed by a wall 3.0 metres in height, provision of an ATM machine and a mobile scissor lift, erection of fencing 2.0 metres in height, erection of a detached two storey building to use the ground floor under Use Classes A1: Shops, or Class A3: Restaurants and Cafes, or Class B1: Businesses, as defined in The Town and Country (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) and to use the first floor of the building as a flat, Class C3: Dwelling Houses of the Order, provision of parking, alterations to existing vehicular and pedestrian access and construction of a new vehicular access on the site of existing buildings and a dwelling which are to be demolished

At a site at 22 Market Place, Tattershall, Lincolnshire.

An Inspector appointed by the First Secretary of State under Paragraph 1 (1) of Schedule 6 to the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 will attend at the place, date and time shown above to decide the appeal.

Member of public may attend the hearing and, at the discretion of the Inspector, express their views. If you are disabled or anyone you know who wants to go to the hearing is disabled, contact the Council to confirm they can make proper arrangements such as parking spaces, access, seating arrangements and so on.
