How are these results measured?

The tests are done to check compliance with standards set in the Bathing Water Directive.

The Directive sets limits for a number of substances, and all countries in the European Union have to ensure their popular beaches meet these standards.

‘Two thumbs up’: Water quality in the sample met the Directive’s most stringent Guideline standards

‘Thumbs up’: Water quality in the sample met the Directive’s main Mandatory standards

‘Thumbs down’: Water quality in the sample failed to meet the main Mandatory standards
