

Refuse and recycling collection changes

- your questions answered

From 17 January 2011 refuse and recycling collections will be changing, this may mean a change of collection day or an alternative way in which you present your waste bin.

Alternatively collection calendars will be delivered in December.

Q: Why are you changing collections?

To give local people better value for money by making the refuse collection rounds more cost effective and at the same time reduce carbon emissions. Nationally, Councils need to reduce their running costs. East Lindsey, like other Councils, will need to make substantial savings of £6.5m from a £22m revenue budget.

Q: What is the benefit of changing the collections?

Changing the collection rounds will save local people over £100,000 each year.

Q: Can I find out now if my collections are changing?

Yes, you can view your new collection calendar online by entering your postcode on the Council's website www.eldc/wastecollection. You will also have a new calendar posted to you in December.

Q: When are collections changing?

Collections will be changing from the week commencing 17 January 2011.

Q: Will I continue to receive a green waste collection?

Yes, you will continue to receive a green waste collection during the summer months, and green waste collections will be suspended during the winter period. However the way you present your green waste bin may be different to how you present it now.

Q: How will this affect me?

This depends on your property. Some residents may see a change of collection day and/or a change of bin combination. Please check your calendar carefully for changes.
