Proposed Development at FLOOD DEFENCES SOUTH SITE, MAIN ROAD, SALTFLEET

I give notice that Environment Agency, is applying to East Lindsey District Council, for Planning Permission - Tetney to Saltfleet tidal flood defence scheme incorporating the following elements:

- raising and widening a 3.6km section of the existing flood defence embankment between Tetney and Grainthorpe;
 - raising and widening a 1.7km section of the existing flood defence embankment east of North Somercotes;
 - raising and widening existing tidal flood defences, and construction of new tidal flood defences, at Saltfleet Haven;
 - a change of land use of approximately 4.5ha landwards of haven bank from agriculture to wildlife habitat;
 - 3no. associated temporary construction compounds, material storage and handling areas, parking and temporary portable site offices, and welfare facilities., reference number N/155/01099/11
- and that the application is accompanied by an environmental impact assessment.
