

Planning Inquiry for VIKING LINK NATIONAL GRID, SANDILANDS (TO BICKER FEN), MABLETHORPE

A PLANNING Inquiry will take place at Tedder Hall, Manby Park, Manby, Louth, Lincolnshire, LN11 8UP starting on Tuesday 6th November 2018 at 10am.

The Inquiry relates to a planning application by National Grid Viking Link Ltd, for Viking Link National Grid, Sandilands (to Bicker Fen), Mablethorpe, Lincolnshire. The Inquiry was initially refused by East Lindsey District Council for Planning Permission for the Works to facilitate the Viking Link electrical interconnector with an approximate capacity of 1400 megawatts (MW) extending from Revsing, Jutland, (Denmark) to Bicker Fen, Lincolnshire (UK) comprising:

Installation of 2 subsea high voltage direct current (DC) cables between Mean Low Water Springs (MLWS) and landfall at Boygrift in East Lindsey;
Installation of 2 onshore DC cables between the landfall at Boygrift and the converter station at North Ing Drove in South Holland;
Erection of converter station buildings (relating to land in adjoining authority);
together with temporary and permanent ancillary infrastructure.

An independent Planning Inspector appointed by the Government will oversee the appeal. The public are invited to attend the Inquiry and at the discretion of the Inspector, may express their views on the application.
