

**LICENSING ACT 2003 - APPLICATION  
FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES  
LICENCE**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that an application for the review of a Premises Licence under the above-mentioned legislation has been made by Lincolnshire Police to East Lindsey District Council in respect of a premise known as **The Agra Restaurant & Takeaway, 12 Lawrence Street, Horncastle, LN9 5BJ.**

The grounds of the application for review relate to the Prevention of Crime and Disorder & Public Safety licensing objectives – the review applicant (Lincolnshire Police) is of the opinion that the premises has employed an illegal worker contrary to immigration legislation.

The record of the application for review may be inspected at the offices of The Licensing Team, East Lindsey District Council, Tedder Hall, Manby Park, Louth, LN11 8UP, during normal office hours.

Responsible Authorities and other parties may also make representations regarding the premises licence and the premises licence review. Any representation must be made in writing to the Licensing Team, East Lindsey District Council at the above address by **12 March 2020.**

It is an offence, liable on summary conviction to a fine up to Level 5 (£5000) on the standard scale, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with the review application.
