- 1** Visit the website
www.householdresponse.com/eastlindsey
- 2** Enter your unique security code

- 3** Update your household information and submit
Include the names and nationalities of everyone who lives at this address

If you add any new people they will also need to complete a registration application. They can do this at gov.uk/register-to-vote. We will send each person a form if they do not apply online.

What happens if I don't update or confirm my details online?

If you do not respond online, you will receive a communication by post in September.

Why am I receiving email correspondence?

We have contacted you via email as you provided us with your email address previously. You have the right to object to the use of your email address for the purposes of electoral registration.
