

EAST LINDSEY DISTRICT COUNCIL PUBLIC NOTICE

The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012:

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 10 of The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the Leader of the Council, on the ~~12th November 2024~~, will be requested to take a Key Decision in respect of an additional budget spend from the Decarbonisation of Assets Reserve to support works at Louth, Horncastle and Skegness Leisure Centres.

The Chairman of the Overview Committee has been notified by the Proper Officer of the intention to make the aforementioned Key Decision in accordance with Regulation 10. Regulation 9 of The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 provides that where the Executive Board propose to make a key decision, that decision must not be made until at least 28 clear days public notice has been given. Where it is not possible to give 28 clear days' notice, Regulation 10 of the above Regulations require that the Council must make available at its offices, and publish on its website, a notice setting out the reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable.

Reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable -

The report was not included in the forward plan as a key decision due to final costs only being confirmed on 21st October 2024. The requirement to commence works by 9th December 2024 to minimise disruption means a timely decision on this matter is required by the Leader of the Council.
