REASON FOR HEARING

Appeal by Mr. A. Gray, relating to the application refused by East Lindsey District Council for the Planning Permission - Change of use of land to use as a gypsy/traveller caravan site comprising: a warden's pitch accommodating a static caravan/mobile home and, 10 transit pitches, each accommodating no more than 2 touring caravans, erection of toilet/wash block and, erection of dayroom building and laying of hardstanding (works commenced) at Stickney Showground, East Fen Lane, Stickney, Boston, Lincolnshire, PE22 8DE.

An Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State will hold a hearing on the date and time shown above to decide the appeal.

Documents relating to the appeal can be viewed at the Council website Application ref no. S/126/01403/23. Anyone wishing to attend the hearing must make that interest known to the Planning Inspectorate Case Officer as soon as possible prior to the Hearing either by email or telephone after reading the Hearing Attendance Information set out below. When contacting the Case Officer, it would be helpful if you could confirm whether you want to take an active part in the discussions or anticipate attending just as an observer (see the below).
