Guidance Note No. 15

Location of Notches and Holes




This guidance note indicates the position of notches and holes in simply supported floor and roof joists

Notches

Should be:

- Only be made in the top edge of the joist
- ❖ No deeper than 0.125 times the depth of the joist
- ❖ No closer to the support than 0.07 times the span
- ❖ No further away from the support than 0.25 times the span




All holes & notches should be located within the area shown

Holes

Should be:

- Only drilled on the centre line of the joist
- ❖ Have a diameter no greater than 0.25 the depth of the joist
- ❖ No less than 3 diameters (centre to centre) apart
- ❖ No closer to the support than 0.25 times the span
- ❖ No further away from the support than 0.40 times the span



- ❖ The span of a joist is measured from wall face to wall face
- ❖ If the above requirements cannot be met within the limitations shown, then increase the joist depth by the depth of notches or diameter of holes.
- ❖ No notches or holes should be cut in roof rafters other than at supports where rafters may be Birdsmouthed to a depth not exceeding 0.33 times the depth of the rafter.
