Description of Development - Works to facilitate the Viking Link electrical interconnector with an approximate capacity of 1400 megawatts (MW) extending from Revsing, Jutland, (Denmark) to Bicker Fen, Lincolnshire (UK) comprising:

Installation of 2 subsea high voltage direct current (DC) cables between Mean Low Water Springs (MLWS) and landfall at Boygrift in East Lindsey;

Installation of 2 onshore DC cables between the landfall at Boygrift and the converter station at North Ing Drove in South Holland;

Erection of converter station buildings (relating to land in adjoining authority);
