

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**  
**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257**  
**AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14**

EAST LINDSEY DISTRICT COUNCIL  
EAST LINDSEY (CHAPEL ST LEONARDS) (PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH 42) PUBLIC PATH  
DIVERSION ORDER 2018

On 11 July 2018, East Lindsey District Council confirmed, unopposed, the above order.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to:

Divert that part of Public Footpath 42 running from the unaffected part of Public Footpath 42 at Ordnance Survey Grid Ref: TF 5549 7197 (Point A on the order map) and curving round in a generally east south easterly then south easterly direction for approximately 182 metres to terminate at the unaffected part of Public Footpath 42 at Ordnance Survey Grid Ref: TF 5562 7186 (Point B on the order map). Total length of footpath to be diverted is approximately 182 metres as shown between points A-B on the order map AND TO create a new footpath to be 2 metres wide running from the unaffected part of Public Footpath 42 at Ordnance Survey Grid Ref: TF 5549 7197 (Point A on the order map) along the estate footway in a south easterly then east south easterly direction for approximately 183 metres to Ordnance Survey Grid Ref: TF 5563 7186 (Point C on the order map) then running in a south-westerly direction for approximately 6 metres to terminate at the unaffected part of Public Footpath 42 at Ordnance Survey Grid Ref: TF 5562 7186 (Point B on the order map). Total length of footpath to be added to be approximately 189 metres as shown between points A-C-B on the order map.

A copy of the confirmed order and the order map may be seen free of charge at the District Council Offices from 9am to 5pm on Monday to Friday.

The Order came into force on 11 July 2018, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, or on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date of which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
